Entry Fee: \$40.00 for adults, \$15 for juniors. (includes BASF fee)

Entries: **Entries limited to 30 shooters**

Entries will be accepted on first come/first serve basis until all firing points are filled.

Competitors must have a CMP competitor number and sign and return the CMP affidavit with their entry.

Location: Ben Avery Shooting Facility High Power Range

Safety rules: Approved empty chamber indicators (ECIs) are required to be in all rifles except during prep and firing periods. ECIs can be purchased from the match staff for \$2 each. Safety glasses and ear protection must be worn by all competitors and spectators on or near the firing line.

Roll call **Pit e-target set-up at 8:00 a.m. Firing will start is 9 a.m.**

Classifications: CMP/NRA High Power classifications will not be used for awards. Scores will be submitted to CMP.

Categories: Adult and Junior (rule 3.6.3). Junior category exists only in the Service Rifle Division and Junior awards will be given only in the Service Rifle Division.

Divisions:
1. CMP Service Rifle, (rules 5.1.1 - 5.1.4)
2. CMP Match Rifle, (rule 5.1.5)

- Scoring:** Scoring will be done using Shot Marker e-targets, eliminating pit-changes.
- Ammunition:** Competitors must provide their own safe and permitted ammo, (88 rounds, plus spares for alibis) The match director will have the authority to deem ammunition and rifles unsafe for competition. The range does not allow tracer, incendiary, AP or steel projectiles due to fire risk most of the year.
- Targets:** 200-yards standing/sitting NRA SR target. 300-yard prone SR-3. 600-yard MR-1.
- Challenges:** A fee of \$3.00 will be collected for each challenge. The match director can select and preside over a jury of three competitors to vote on challenges, but match director cannot vote.
- Course of Fire:** Service Rifle Standard Match 4X20 shots (rule 6.5). Two sighters will be given per stage and only range alibis will be granted. Competitors will start the rapid-fire events in the firing position (no starting from standing). Rapid fire sitting will have a 60 second time limit and rapid fire prone will have a 70 second time limit. (rule 6.2.4.c). (Rapid fire strings are split into separate matches to accommodate e-target scoring).

Match 1: 200 yd. Slow-Fire Standing. 2 sighters & 20 shots for record in 22 minutes. SR Target.

Match 2a: 200 yd. Rapid-Fire Sitting. 2 sighters plus one 10-shot string, rapid fire, sitting or kneeling 60 secs per string. SR Target.

Match 2b: 200 yd. Rapid-Fire Sitting. One 10-shot string, rapid fire, sitting or kneeling 60 secs per string. SR Target.

Match 3a: 300 yd. Rapid Prone. 2 sighters plus one 10-shot string, rapid fire prone, 70 secs per string. SR-3 Target.

Match 3b: 300 yd. Rapid Prone. One 10-shot string, rapid fire prone, 70 secs per string. SR-3 Target.

Match 4: 600 yd. Slow-Fire Prone. 2 sighters plus 20 shots for record in 22 minutes. MR-1 Target.

Match 5: Aggregate of Matches 1, 2a, 2b, 3a, 3b and 4. Service Rifle and Match Rifle Divisions.

Awards: Winners will be awarded for high-score in each division and for high Junior in the Service Rifle Division. Each champion will receive a plaque. There must be at least five shooters in a division and four service rifle juniors for a winner to be declared. First, second, and third place medals will be awarded for adults and juniors, providing there are least six shooters competing per division. A junior may elect to shoot outside the junior category by entering as an adult. All juniors competing in the match rifle division must enter as adults. If there is insufficient attendance for full awards, the match director will reduce and/or combine awards as the match director deems appropriate.
