Entries will be limited to 28 competitors: A competitor may shoot all or part of the tournament. Preference will be given those shooting the entire tournament on a first come, first serve basis.

Advanced entries close Wednesday, August 17, 2011. Specify relay 1 (Saturday) or relay 2 (Sunday). Post entries will be accepted until 30 minutes prior to firing each day based on availability and the stated limit of the range.

### MATCH SCHEDULE

The tournament will be fired entirely at 25 yards in the following sequence on the listed NRA approved targets. Ten shots will be fired per target. Competitors will score on cards provided and will repair/replace their own targets. There will be a break for lunch between the center fire matches and the .45 caliber matches.

**Relay # 1:** Firing will commence at 8:00 AM Saturday, August 20, 2011

**Relay # 2:** Firing will commence at 8:00 AM Sunday, August 21, 2011

**Warm-up/Sight-in:** Each day at 7:45 am, 10 minutes, unlimited shots, any gun, target not scored
