

Phoenix Rod & Gun Club Presents a Big Bore Rifle Shoot

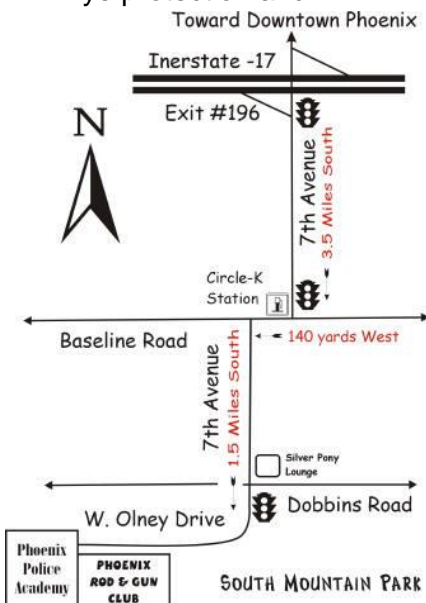


A fun shoot with African Style Big Bore Rifles at Big Game Targets.

- African Big Bore Rifles: Bolt, Double, Single shot etc any big African caliber, 9.3 & up. – Make sure its zeroed for your hunting preference.
- Bring at least 20 rds of full power ammo
- Safari equipment such as shooting sticks permitted. Dress as you would for a hunt in this weather. Pith helmets optional!
- Multiple stages, precision or speed shooting. Details announced on shoot-day, may include shoot/don't shoot scenarios. Reasonable dangerous game hunting distances, out to one hundred yards.
- Targets will be full size and reduced size African dangerous or plains game targets. Stationary or moving targets. Plus a few shots on Bullseye targets.
- Hit/Miss/Wound & shoot/no-shoot scoring, to judge your skills, but this is a fun shooting not a championships.
- Even if you don't reload, don't throw your brass away!
- Carefully aimed shots only. Participants will alternate shooting, scoring and marking targets. Bring Ear & Eye protection and WATER! 9AM start, 7:30AM set up.



- Fee \$20, (discount for PRGC members), Reduced rate for 2nd gun or refire. Limit 20 shooters, email Arizona@rifleshooting.org to pre-register or for questions.
